Validation of the Spanish version of the voice handicap index for vocal singing (SVHI)

Validación de la revisión en español del índice de incapacidad vocal (SVHI) para el canto

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In the article "Validation of the Spanish version for the singing voice handicap index (SVHI)" (Acta Otorrinolaringol Esp. 2010;61:247-54), the following errors have been found:

- Where it states: "Regarding the SVHI-10 validated in English, it only differed in 2 items from that proposed above (1, 6, 7, 10, 15, 17, 18, 29, 31 and 32)", it should say: "With respect to the SVHI-10 validated in English, it coincided with only 3 items from that proposed above (1, 3, 11, 15, 16, 18, 23, 24, 28, 31)."
- Where it states: "Both questionnaires, the original SVHI-10 and the SVHI-10 derived from the Spanish version, share 8 of the 10 items that integrate them..." it should say "Both questionnaires, the original SVHI-10 and the SVHI-10 derived from the Spanish version, share 3 of the 10 items that integrate them..."
- Table 4 on page 251 was published with errors. We reproduce the correct table below:
